



LPG Vehicle Scheme – Program Changes Effective 1 July 2009

Current program arrangements remain in place for LPG conversions and new LPG vehicle purchases completed on or before 30 June 2009. (See LPG Vehicle Scheme Customer Guidelines February 2009 for details).

Changes to LPG Vehicle Scheme Commencing 1 July 2009

Program changes apply to LPG conversions or new LPG vehicle purchases completed on or after 1 July 2009.

From 1 July 2009, there will be two different grants available subject to eligibility criteria:

1. LPG Conversions

For registered vehicles converted to LPG

Grant	Conversion Completed
<u>\$1,750</u>	<u>Between 1 July 2009 and 30 June 2010</u>
\$1,500	Between 1 July 2010 and 30 June 2011
\$1,250	Between 1 July 2011 and 30 June 2012
\$1,000	Between 1 July 2012 and 30 June 2013
\$1,000	Between 1 July 2013 and 30 June 2014

2. New LPG Vehicles

For purchase of a new vehicle fitted with LPG before first registration

Grant	Vehicle Purchase Completed
\$2,000	Between 1 July 2009 and 30 June 2014

There are no changes to program eligibility criteria for LPG conversions or new LPG vehicle purchases completed on or after 1 July 2009.

Converting Your Registered Vehicle To LPG - Frequently Asked Questions

I converted my car to LPG before 1 July 2009. Which grant am I entitled to?

If the conversion is completed on or before 30 June 2009 and all eligibility criteria are met, you are entitled to a grant of \$2,000.

If I convert my car to LPG between 1 July 2009 and 30 June 2010, which grant am I entitled to?

If all eligibility criteria are met, you are entitled to a grant of \$1,750.

I booked my car in for an LPG conversion before 1 July 2009 but the conversion won't be completed until after 1 July 2009. Which grant am I entitled to?

If the conversion is completed between 1 July 2009 and 30 June 2010 and all eligibility criteria are met, you are entitled to a grant of \$1,750.

I converted my car to LPG before 1 July 2009 but I haven't lodged my application yet. Which grant am I entitled to?

Your grant entitlement is determined by the date of LPG conversion, not the date that you lodge your application. If you lodge an eligible claim for a conversion completed **before** 1 July 2009, you are entitled to a grant of \$2,000. Please note that you must lodge your application within 12 months from the date of conversion.

I have lodged an application for an LPG conversion completed before 1 July 2009. I haven't been advised of the result. Which grant am I entitled to?

Your grant entitlement is determined by the date of LPG conversion, not the date that we make a decision about your application. If you have lodged an eligible claim for a conversion completed **before** 1 July 2009, you are entitled to a grant of \$2,000.

Are there any special circumstances that will entitle me to a grant of \$2,000 for an LPG conversion that is completed after 1 July 2009?

No – the maximum grant available for an LPG conversion completed after 30 June 2009 is \$1,750.

Do I have to nominate the grant amount in my application?

No - we will determine which grant you are entitled to on the basis of your application information.

Purchase of New LPG Vehicles - Frequently Asked Questions

I purchased my new vehicle fitted with LPG before first registration before 1 July 2009. Which grant am I entitled to?

If you purchased your new LPG vehicle on or after 10 November 2008 and you meet all program eligibility criteria, you are entitled to a grant of \$2,000. If you purchased your new LPG vehicle before 10 November 2008, please ring the AusIndustry Hotline on 13 28 46 for more information.

From 1 July 2009, are there different grant amounts for the purchase of new vehicles fitted with LPG before first registration?

No – there is a single grant of \$2,000 for all new vehicles fitted with LPG prior to first registration. This includes vehicles fitted with LPG at time of manufacture, and vehicles fitted with LPG after manufacture but before first registration.

I purchased my new vehicle fitted with LPG before first registration after 1 July 2009. Which grant am I entitled to?

Assuming all eligibility criteria were met, you are entitled to a grant of \$2,000.

Do I have to nominate the grant amount in my application?

No - we will determine which grant you are entitled to on the basis of your application information.
